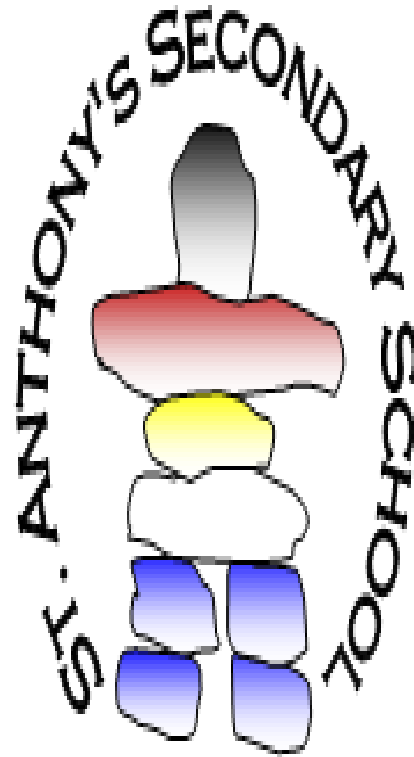




- Students will be considered as part time if they

NB: There must be at least three registered students in a course for it to be offered.

Entry Requirements.

- All Students must have passed English A at CSEC or an equivalent grade from any other accredited examination boards.

- In order to attempt a subject at CAPE, students must have obtained that subject at CSEC.
- Two letters of Recommendation from former Principal/Teachers.
- A desire for higher education.



Tuition & Fees – Students have the options to be fulltime or part time.

- Registration Fee EC\$250.00
- Fee for fulltime students is EC\$3600.00 per term – there are three terms in the year.
- Fees for part-time students is EC\$900.00 per course per semester.
- Students will be considered fulltime if they
 - a. Register to take four (4) A' Level courses or more for a duration of two years.
 - b. Register to take 3 A' Level courses and one or two O'Levels for a duration of two years.
 - c. If determined as a full time students under special circumstances.
 - d. Complete a mandatory 1 hour per week voluntary work program that will run the duration of the two years.
